

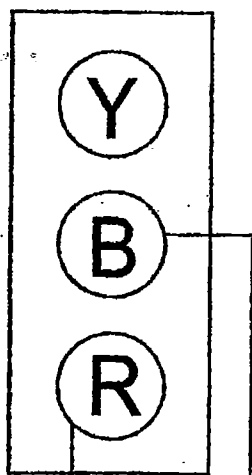
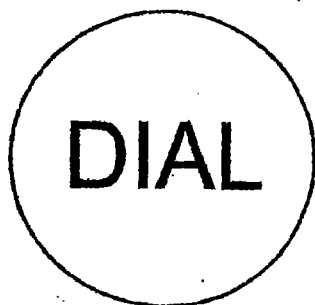

BY UNSCREWING THE 4
PHILLIPS HEAD SCREWS

2. HOLD UNIT AS SHOWN WITH DIAL
FACING AWAY AND THE THREE
COLOR CODED BRASS SCREW

TERMINALS TOWARDS YOU (AS SHOWN)

3. EACH BRASS SCREW TERMINAL
HAS A COLORED DOT NEXT TO IT

YELLOW (Y)

BLUE (B)

RED (R)

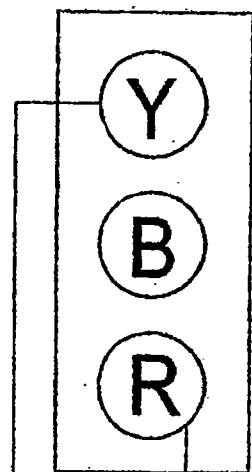
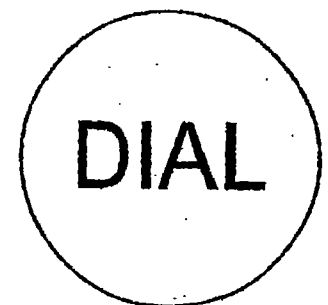
4. UNSCREW THE BLUE CODED
SCREW TERMINAL (CENTER) AND
REMOVE THE WHITE WIRE

5. UNSCREW THE YELLOW CODED
SCREW TERMINAL (CLOSEST TO DIAL)
AND TIGHTEN SECURELY ON
THE WHITE WIRE

6. CHECK THAT ALL SCREW
TERMINALS ARE SECURELY
TIGHTENED

7. REPLACE COVER AND GASKET
AND TIGHTEN FIRMLY

Limited Warranty

One-Year Limited Warranty. Any part which is determined to be defective in material or workmanship and returned to an authorized service location, as K-Kontrols designates, shipping costs prepaid, will be, as the exclusive remedy, repaired or replaced at K-Kontrols' option. For limited warranty claim procedures see PROMPT DISPOSITION below. This limited warranty gives purchases specific legal rights which vary from state to state.

Limitation of Liability. To the extent allowable under applicable law, K-Kontrols' liability for consequential and incidental damages is expressly disclaimed. K-Kontrols' liability in all events is limited to and shall not exceed the purchase price paid.
